Several felt a strong burden for this man and his wife. We have found favor with them and are believing God to save them. We gave out shoes and some clothing before the evening church service.

In San Juan, we ministered in the streets, handing out tracts and the Gospel of John to several hundred people. Many received the Word joyfully.

We were again thankful to Bro. Craig Benner and his family for carrying the load of translating for 17 people. We were accompanied by Bro. Danny Daulton and his son Jordon. Bro. Jeff Hertzler and his son Dallas, Sis. Constance Johnson, and my beautiful wife Rochelle.
