

Gary Johnson and Wibrick (Lil dub) Padgett. With this group of hard working men, we were able to start the construction of a new parsonage for Bro. Narciso, our Pastor in El Pinal. We dug and poured the footing, laid the block in preparation of the slab and cleared away an old fence row to gain better entrance into the property. We are thankful to Sis. Gina Hall for providing the funds to make this house a reality for Bro. Narciso.

We were also given the privilege of ministering in the public school in El Pinal. We were able to give Bible, school supplies, and candy

to each student and present each teacher with a tablet. We also were able to donate a computer to the school. One of the teachers told the students to begin learning where the books in the Bible are so they could look up certain scriptures in class! They will be using the Bible as a text book—Praise the Lord!



We have finished the construction work on the warehouse at Lavapie and now we are beginning to make plans to construct the perimeter wall. A Brother who felt led of the Lord to fund this project has sent HSM \$6,000 to build a wall.



We held an open air service in Lavapie Sunday Morning and had about 45 in attendance.

There is a hunger for God's Word in this village. We are hoping to begin work on the church very soon.

When the warehouse was constructed, water had to be hauled from the river to mix cement. Hector Quezada has helped us make contact with a government official who, after learning the nature of our ministry, has agreed to drill and install a well on our property for the cost of labor and material. The cost will bet about \$1,700.00 plus a couple hundred for the tank. We are planning a construction and ministry mission trip in September This would be a great opportunity to get involved in missions.
